Subject: Transportation of Medication

A number of students/individuals have prescribed medications that are transported to the day programming site.

Some are capable of carrying their own medications to and from their day programming site.

If the individual is not capable of carrying the medication safely, the medication should be given to the Driver when the individual boards the bus. The Bus Driver is to place the medications in the poly box located beside the driver.

Residential facilities may transport medications in their own storage boxes. These boxes should be placed in a designated area beside the bus driver.

Upon arrival at the day programming site, all medications and medication boxes are to be given to the Bus Unloader.

NOTE: Medications delivered to Southgate School are to remain in the poly box and the entire poly box given to the bus unloader. The poly box will be returned on the evening run.
